

Sammy Steinmark is the younger brother of Freddie Joe Steinmark, and was a special contributor to the book *Freddie Steinmark: Faith, Family, Football*, as well as a consultant to the movie *My All American*. Sammy played college football at the University of Texas under Coach Darrell Royal and the University of Wyoming, under Coach Fred Akers, who was Freddie Joe Steinmark's defensive back coach at Texas. Sammy then signed with the Minnesota Vikings of the NFL and the Denver Broncos. An injury ended his playing career and he became an assistant coach at Wyoming, an Assistant Coach at Air Force, and Assistant Head Coach at Navy before moving into a career as an executive in the oil industry.
